Lior Zoref is a researcher, advisor, TED speaker and author of the bestselling book, Mindsharing – the art of crowdsourcing everything.


He gave a talk at TED 2012 in Long Beach California. The New Yorker magazine called his standing ovation TED performance 'delightful'.
